





Pairing Concerto

1. Press and hold the power button for 3 seconds to power on. You will hear a startup chime. The indicator light will begin flashing red and blue. You are now in pairing mode.



Note: If no devices are paired within 5 minutes, Concerto will automatically turn off. Turn Concerto back on to re-enter pairing mode.

2. Go to your phone's Settings. Find your Bluetooth® settings.



Note: If you are having trouble, please refer to your device's support manual.

3. You should see Concerto listed in the list of nearby Bluetooth® devices. If you do not see Concerto, make sure that you are in pairing mode (the indicator light will flash red and blue).




4. Tap on the device named Concerto to pair by Bluetooth®. Once paired, you will hear a sound indicating a successful pairing and the indicator light will be solid blue.

5. Play your favorite tunes on Concerto!

6. Press the power button and hold for 3 seconds to turn Concerto off.

Note: To pair Concerto with another device, you must first disconnect any devices currently paired by either:

- Turning off the first device's Bluetooth®
- Forgetting Concerto as a paired device
- Taking the paired device out of range of the Concerto



Recharging Concerto

When your speaker is running low on battery, it will make a low beep approximately every 10 seconds. To recharge the Concerto, insert the micro USB end of the included charging cable into the charging port of the Concerto. Insert the USB end of the cable into a USB power source (computer, USB charger, etc).

Charging Other Devices

Use the USB charging cable that came with the device you'd like to charge and plug it into the back of Concerto behind the silicone cover. Press the charge button to begin charging.



Using the Speaker Phone

While your speaker is playing music and you receive a phone call, you will hear the ring through Concerto. You can press the answer button on Concerto to pick up the phone call. When you are done, press the same button again to hang up. You can also pick up and hang up phone calls on your phone while connected to the Concerto.
